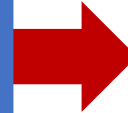
If you are experiencing any cough, cold or ear, nose & throat symptoms, and require medical assistance or advice, please first contact your family physician or primary health care provider.

OR

If you or your child (aged 2 years or older) do not have a family physician or are unable to reach your regular primary health care provider,

Same-day appointments for physician assessment by phone/video (possible on-site assessment with paramedics and physicians) to determine the best management options for you or your child.



Life-threatening emergency?

Call 911 or immediately go to the nearest Emergency Department if your child has the following signs or symptoms;

- difficulty breathing
- becoming very pale or blue around the lips
- drowsy or not responding to your voice
- a fit or convulsion
- becoming unwell quite quickly
- an accident or injury such as a burn, broken bone or cut that may need stitches
- a rash that does not fade when pressed

OR

if you think that you or someone else is having;

- a stroke or heart attack
- heavy bleeding
- unconsciousness
- severe breathing difficulties



Instructions on how to best care for yourself and treat your symptoms if you have mild to moderate illness.



Home or clinic visit if essential to further assess and/or administer treatment.
